Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,


I am requesting funding for the Garden City, Utah Road Improvements project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Garden City. The funding would be used to reconstruct the Foothill Estates Subdivision's privately maintained gravel roads into a modern, asphalt-surfaced roadway system and to upgrade undersized water lines.

The investment in the Garden City, Utah Road Improvements project represents a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it addresses critical safety risks that currently impede emergency service access. It resolves a vital public safety need by meeting modern fire flow requirements, protecting both the 40+ property owners and the surrounding area. Beyond the subdivision, these improvements enhance access to the nearby Garden City Canyon recreational area and provide essential secondary ingress and egress points to resolve current bottlenecks.

This project has a Federal nexus because it is for purposes authorized under 23 USC 133 (b).
