
I am requesting funding for the Box Elder County, Utah Emergency Medical Services Equipment project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Box Elder County. The funding would be used to purchase two ambulances, cardiac monitors, and retrofit autoloader/power cot stretchers to provide service to an underserved population in Box Elder County.

The investment in the Box Elder County, Utah Emergency Medical Services Equipment project represents a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it directly addresses a critical need in rural emergency medical services, which are essential for the health, safety, and well-being of residents across a geographically expansive and sparsely populated area. This project will improve response times and coverage, enhance quality of care, strengthen emergency preparedness and resilience, support rural residents and visitors, and foster long-term economic and social benefits for the community.

This project has a Federal nexus because it is for purposes authorized in Section 306 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. §242k), which authorizes federal support for improving emergency medical services systems and expanding access to emergency care in rural and underserved communities.
