Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,


I am requesting funding for the Great Salt Lake Stansbury Bay Improvement project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is The Office of the Great Salt Lake Commissioner. The funding would be used to reconnect existing hydrology back to the Great Sale Lake by modifying dikes and impoundment systems that are currently preventing natural runoff and precipitation from entering the lake.

The investment in the Great Salt Lake Stansbury Bay Improvement project represents a valuable use of taxpayer funds because a drying Great Salt Lake has local and regional consequences and could result in increased dust, poor air quality, reduced snow, reduced lake access, habitat loss and negative economic consequences to the state. Protecting the lake helps the Utah economy, environment, wildlife and future.

This project has a Federal nexus because it is for purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(4).
