
I am requesting funding for the Logan City, Utah Land Purchase Funding in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Logan City. The funding would be used to purchase 1.53 acres of land for constructing housing for households with low to moderate income (LMI) nearby Utah State University.

The investment in the Logan City, Utah Land Purchase Funding project represents a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it provides a sustainable remedy to supply-side housing constraints in Logan and Cache County through new low-to-middle income housing units. Moreover, the development stands to be a catalyst to nearby housing construction.

This project has a Federal nexus because it is for purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and 5305(a)(5) of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. These sections authorize Community Development Block Grant funds for acquisition of real property, including blighted, deteriorated, or undeveloped land, for rehabilitation, public facilities, and economic development activities that principally benefit low- and moderate-income persons, such as the proposed affordable housing, university-adjacent married student housing, walkability improvements, and trailhead public access.
