Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,


I am requesting funding for the North Logan City for Culinary Water Well project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is North Logan City. The funding would be used to support a new culinary water well to supplement existing wells operating at or near capacity.

The investment in the North Logan City for Culinary Water Well project represents a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it directly protects public health and ensures a safe, reliable drinking water supply for the existing population. The project helps relieve the financial burden on North Logan City residents while addressing critical infrastructure needs. It will also assist in lifting current water restrictions that have been in place for 6 years by providing the additional capacity necessary to meet peak demand for the community.

This project has a Federal nexus because it is for purposes authorized in the Safe Water Drinking Act (42 U.S.C. § 300j-12, Section 1452); EPA State and Tribal Assistance Grants, Drinking Water State Revolving Fund.
