
I am requesting funding for the Ogden, Utah Accessibility Improvements project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Ogden City Corporation. The funding would be used to implement a coordinated infrastructure project focused on improving connectivity along the Historic 25th Street and Union Station corridor, part of the congressionally designated Crossroads of the West National Historic District.

The investment in the Ogden City Infrastructure Development project represents a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it provides targeted infrastructure improvements within an existing, high-impact economic corridor rather than creating new facilities. By enhancing connectivity, safety, and accessibility along the corridor, the project leverages an existing public asset to generate increased economic activity through tourism, events, and small business growth.

This project has a Federal nexus because it is for purposes authorized in Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. § 5301 et seq.). The proposed pedestrian, streetscape, and accessibility improvements are eligible public improvement activities under 42 U.S.C. § 5305(a), supporting economic and community development within a congressionally designated historic district.
