Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,


I am requesting funding for the Utah Paradise Parkway Corridor project in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Garden City, located at 69 N. Paradise Parkway, Building B, Garden City, UT 84028. The funding would be used for the completion of the second phase of the Paradise Parkway Corridor.

The investment in the Utah Paradise Parkway Corridor project represents a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it will create a north-south alternate/bypass route for traffic flow along the main arterial roadway through Town. This Parkway reduces traffic congestion, will significantly increase roadway safety, and will provide connection to new development.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding is for purposes authorized in 23 USC 133 (b).
