Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,


I am requesting funding for the Logan, Utah Water Reclamation Facility Expansion project in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is The City of Logan, located at 153 N 1400 W, Logan, UT 84321. The funding would be used to expand capacity response to the 2010 EPA findings that Cutler Reservoir was impaired due to low dissolved oxygen, Logan City constructed a \$150 million mechanical treatment plant, completed in 2022, to meet stringent ammonia, phosphorus, and nitrogen standards.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will allow for the facility to expand further to meet growing demand of the participating cities.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding is for purposes authorized in Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. 1381 et seq.
