
I am requesting funding for the Summit County, Utah Kimball Junction Overpass project in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is Summit County, Utah, located at 60 N. Main, Coalville, UT 84017. The funding would be used to design and construct a pedestrian overpass to increase public safety, ease traffic congestion and enhance multimodal connectivity for residents, workers, and visitors traveling through this high-traffic, economically vital corridor.

The investment in the Summit County, Utah Pedestrian Overpass project represents a valuable use of taxpayer funds as it is part of a broader coordinated effort with the Utah Department of Transportation's planned improvements to the Kimball Junction/I-80 interchange, the pedestrian overpass will also serve as a critical infrastructure investment as the region prepares to host the 2034 Winter Olympic Games.

This project has a Federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized in 23 U.S. Code § 133, which governs the Surface Transportation Block Grant Program and authorizes funding for pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure projects on federal-aid highways.
