
I am requesting funding for Utah State University's Center for Anticipatory Intelligence project in fiscal year 2022.

The entity to receive funding for this project is Utah State University, located at 5200 Old Main Hill, Logan, Utah 84322.

Funding would be used to bolster Utah State University's Center for Anticipatory Intelligence (CAI), which fuses together cohorts from across the University's 35 different majors to advance 21st century threat assessment and strategic resilience. In particular, funding will be used to primarily support four areas: recruitment travel to schools of interest, targeted in-state student engagement and recruitment, out of state recruitment to underserved populations, and programmatic expenses at CAI to facilitate these student engagement opportunities.
