
Dear Chairwoman Granger and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Clearfield Gateway/Pedestrian Bridges in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is Clearfield City Corporation, located at 55 State Street Clearfield, UT 84015. The funding would be used to build pedestrian gateways/bridges in downtown Clearfield. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because these gateways will increase pedestrian and school children safety, in addition to providing increased placemaking and economic development. Additionally, the project will also support regional efforts to improve multi-modal transportation. The return on investment will be meaningful in these respects, and improvements such as these are not privately financed; the use of taxpayer funds (of one sort or another) is the only way to accomplish them.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
