
Dear Chairwoman Granger and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for The Davis County Teen Resource Center in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is Davis Education Foundation, located at 45 East State Street Farmington, UT 84025. The funding would be used for the construction of the Davis County Teen Resource Center in Layton, Utah. The proposed facility is a two-story, 16-bed structure with a kitchen, lounge areas, offices, storage and outdoor recreation space. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the number of homeless students in Davis County is increasing, yet Davis County is not positioned to help in the most vital ways. To see the societal benefits of a generation of children equipped to rise beyond poverty, Davis County needs to intervene now. Plans for the facility are already drafted. With funding, construction can begin before year's end.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S. Code section 5305(a)(2) and 5305 (a)(4).
