 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Fiscal State of the
- 5 Nation Act".

1SEC. 2. ANNUAL JOINT MEETING OF CONGRESS TO RE-2CEIVE PRESENTATION BY COMPTROLLER3GENERAL.

4 Section 331 of title 31, United States Code, is5 amended by adding at the end the following:

6 "(f) ANNUAL JOINT MEETING OF CONGRESS TO RE7 CEIVE PRESENTATION BY COMPTROLLER GENERAL.—

8 "(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 45 days (ex-9 cluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays) after the 10 date on which the Secretary of the Treasury submits 11 to Congress the audited financial statement required 12 under subsection (e)(1), on a date agreed upon by 13 the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the 14 President pro tempore of the Senate and the Comptroller General of the United States, the Congress 15 16 shall hold a joint meeting (hereafter in this sub-17 section referred to as the 'Joint Meeting') to receive 18 a presentation from the Comptroller General review-19 ing the findings of the audit required under sub-20 section (e)(2) and providing, with respect to the in-21 formation included by the Secretary in the report ac-22 companying such audited financial statement, an 23 analysis of the financial position and condition of the 24 Federal Government, including financial measures 25 (such as the net operating cost, income, budget defi-26 cits, or budget surpluses) and sustainability meas3

ures (such as the long-term fiscal projection or social
 insurance projection) described in such report.

3 "(2) PRESENTATION OF STATEMENT IN AC-4 5 The Comptroller General of the United States shall 6 ensure that the presentation at the Joint Meeting is 7 made in accordance with the Strategies and Means of the Government Accountability Office, so that the 8 9 presentation will provide professional, objective, fact-10 based, nonpartisan, nonideological, fair, and bal-11 anced information to the members attending the 12 Joint Meeting.

13 "(3) OPEN MEETING.—The Joint Meeting shall
14 be open to the public, including to radio, television,
15 and still photography coverage.

16 "(4) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The requirement
17 under paragraph (1) shall apply with respect to any
18 audited financial statement submitted on or after
19 the date of the enactment of the Fiscal State of the
20 Nation Act.".

21 SEC. 3. INCLUSION OF FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF FISCAL 22 STATE OF THE NATION IN CONCURRENT RES23 OLUTION ON THE BUDGET.

24 Section 301(a) of the Congressional Budget and Im-25 poundment Control Act of 1974 (2 U.S.C. 632(a)) is amended by adding at the end the following: "Each con current resolution on the budget shall include a statement
 of findings informed by the most recently conducted Fiscal
 State of the Nation presentation under section 331(f) of
 title 31, United States Code, and any other appropriate
 information on the fiscal condition of the United States.".
