- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Preventing Improper
- 5 Payments Act".

1	SEC. 2. TREATMENT OF CERTAIN NEW PROGRAMS AND AC-
2	TIVITIES.
3	Section 3352(a) of title 31, United States Code, is
4	amended by adding at the end the following:
5	"(4) Rule of construction.—Any program
6	or activity established by a Federal agency on or
7	after the date of the enactment of this paragraph
8	making more than \$100,000,000 in payments in a
9	fiscal year shall be construed to be a program or ac-
10	tivity with outlays exceeding the statutory threshold
11	dollar amount described in paragraph (3)(A)(i) that
12	may be susceptible to significant improper pay-
13	ment.".
14	SEC. 3. REPORT REQUIREMENT.
15	Section 3357(d) of title 31, United States Code, is
16	amended by striking "For each of fiscal years 2019 and
17	2020, each" and inserting the following: "Each".
