A BILL

To amend the Congressional Budget and Impoundment Control Act of 1974 to require the Congressional Budget Office to provide baseline updates, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Increasing Baseline
5 Updates Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CONGRESSIONAL BUDGET OFFICE UPDATES TO**
2 **BASELINE.**

3 Section 202(e) of the Congressional Budget and Im-
4 poundment Control Act of 1974 (2 U.S.C. 602(e)) is
5 amended by adding at the end the following:

6 “(4)(A) The Director shall, to the extent prac-
7 ticable, submit to the Committees on the Budget of
8 the House of Representatives and the Senate at
9 least two updates to the baseline submitted under
10 paragraph (1). At least one of the updates shall in-
11 clude economic data used by the Director to cal-
12 culate such update.

13 “(B) Nothing in this paragraph shall be con-
14 strued to limit the Director from providing any other
15 update to the baseline during such year.”.

16 **SEC. 3. ANNUAL TECHNICAL BUDGET DATA SUBMISSION BY**
17 **THE PRESIDENT.**

18 Section 1106 of title 31, United States Code, is
19 amended by adding at the end the following:

20 “(d) On or before February 1 of each calendar year,
21 the President shall submit to Congress technical budget
22 data for the fiscal year beginning in the ensuing calendar
23 year, which shall include up-to-date estimates for current
24 year and prior year data and credit reestimates for the
25 current year (as included in the Federal credit supplement
26 of such budget).”.
